3,465 Meals Delivered Marking All-Time Record

Friday, July 19 marked a major milestone for Mama's Kitchen. Volunteers prepared, packaged and delivered 385 bags that provided a total of 3,465 meals to nourish our Home Delivered Meal Program clients over the weekend. This is a new record for our current kitchen facility.

With last year's implementation of two new pilot programs that includes clients with diabetes and/or congestive heart failure, there's been a significant increase in demand and an opportunity to serve dozens more clients with our home meal delivery program. Around the same time last year, we delivered to 299 clients for a total of 2,691 meals, putting us at a 29% increase in service over the course of one year. Our goal is to continue this growth to serve 425 clients each day by March 31, 2020. Thanks to all of our volunteers who work diligently to make sure we provide nutritious, medically-tailored, quality meals to our community members.

Client Spotlight

Bonnie has cancer, and treatment was painful and difficult. Her overall health was declining rapidly, and as she got weaker, she was limited in the things she could do to care for herself. "The meal service helped me tremendously," she says. "I used to take food for granted. I never thought I would be someone who was too sick and too poor to even buy and cook food. But there I was-sick, hungry and alone." Bonnie's healthcare provider referred her to Mama's Kitchen, and with the Home-Delivered Meal Service, she was able to eat three healthy meals each day.



"Mama's Kitchen made sure I didn't go hungry," she says. "I probably would've died without them. You think it can't happen to you, but it can happen to anyone. I'll be forever grateful for their help."
